



The Clinical Service Improvement Program

A leadership program for early career clinicians



About the CSI program

The program aims to engage early career clinicians to improve health outcomes through service redesign. Participants identify a key process challenge and are then supported to design and implement improvements to benefit their health site. Each participant receives training on service improvement methods as well as on-site support with project execution by clinical and service improvement supervisors. The program is offered for 10-13 weeks on a full or part-time basis across a range of sites. Previous improvement projects have tackled challenges in surgical processes, discharge planning and communication, and outpatient clinic waiting times.

Leadership development

The CSI Program also includes a fantastic leadership and professional development program. Participants have the opportunity to attend a range of workshops and masterclasses on topics such as leadership and communication skills.
